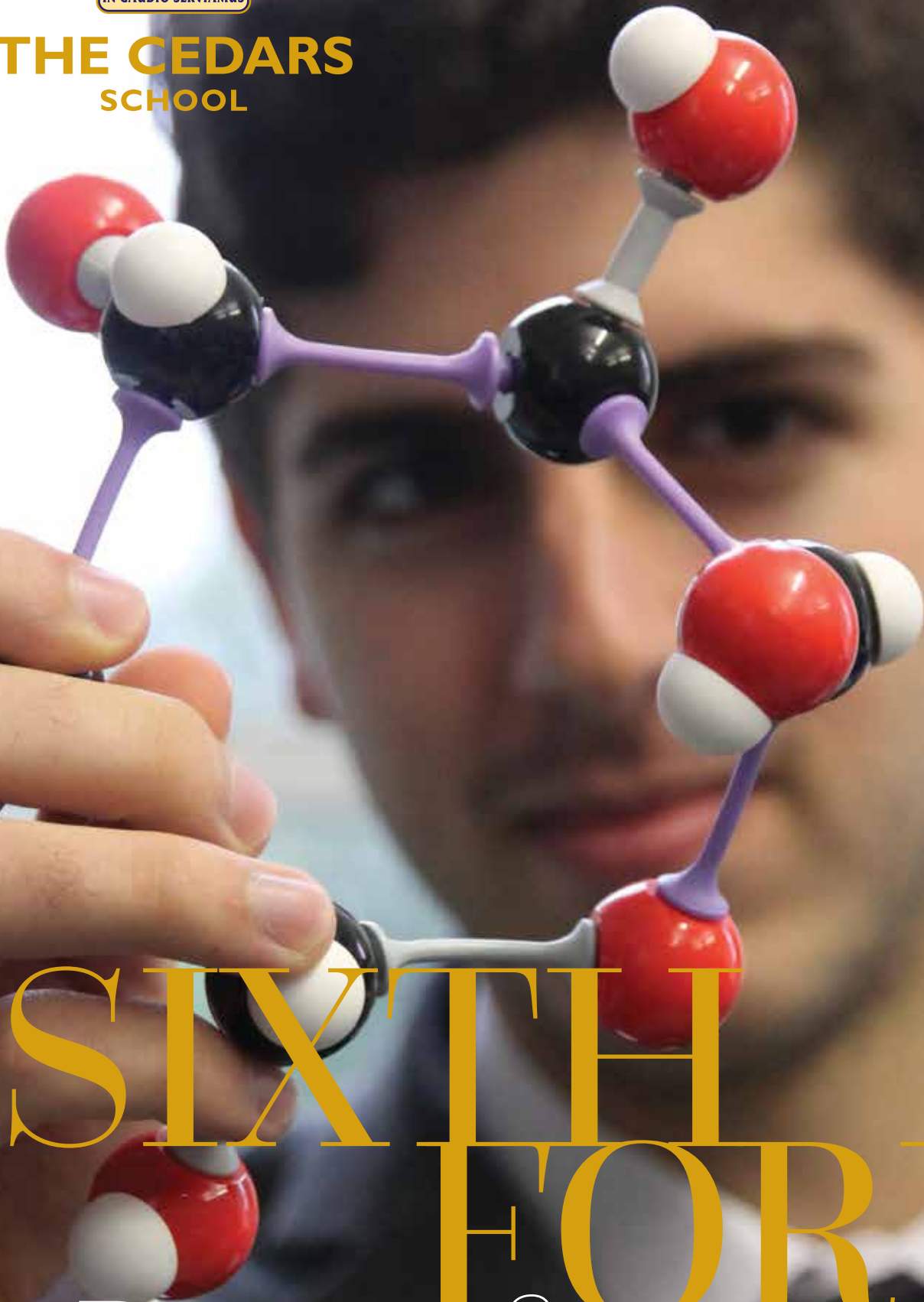

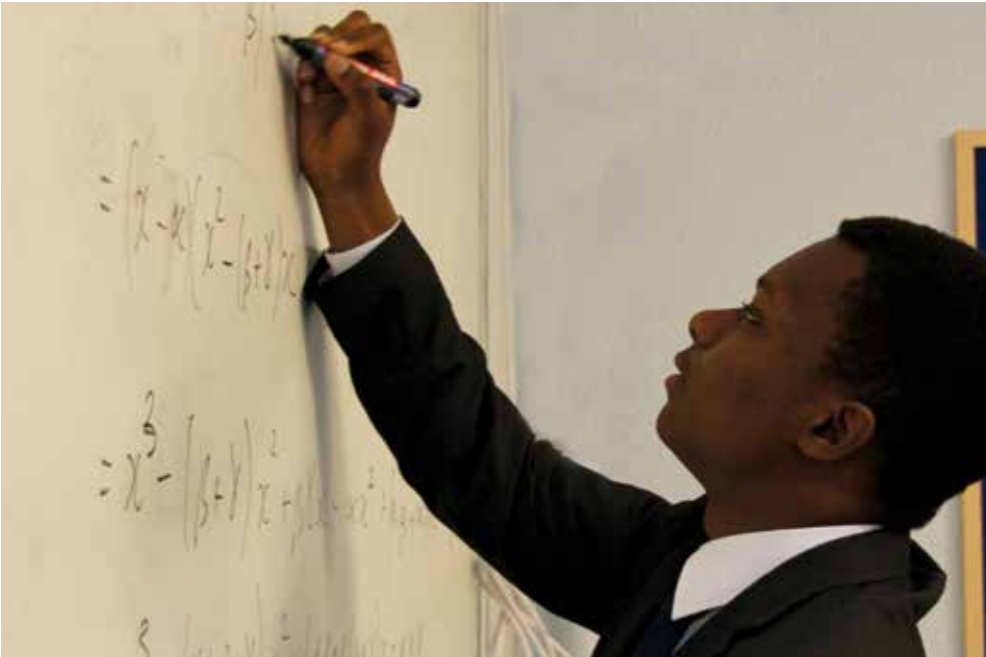
# SIXTH FORM ACADEMIC LIFE
